

Life Group Notes – w/c Sunday 11th October

Key Passage: Hebrews 6:1-3

On Sunday we continued our series on 'Foundations' based on the above verses from Hebrews. This week we looked at **instruction on baptisms** – part 1.

I had 2 main points both of which started with the letter 'P'.

POSITION – baptised into Jesus Christ.

1. Read Ephesians 4:3-6. What is Paul talking about when he says "one baptism"?
2. Read Romans 6:3-4. How would you explain what Paul is talking about in these verses to a new Christian?

What does having died to sin mean in terms of our day-to-day lives?

PROCLAMATION – baptised in water.

3. Do you think it is important for believers to be baptised in water? If so, why??

As a group how many different reasons can you think of for why being baptised in water as a believer is important?

4. Encourage the group to share about how they responded to the gospel, at what stage they decided to be baptised in water and why they took this step.
