Key Passage: Luke 9:1-50

On Sunday morning we continued our series on **the works and words of Jesus** from Luke's gospel.

We thought a little about what it takes to make your mark in life or achieve a measure of greatness. In particular, we looked at a couple of things, which clearly set Jesus apart from his disciples in the passage above.

1. In 1962, Clare Boothe Luce, one of the first women to serve in the U.S. Congress, offered some advice to President John F. Kennedy. 'A great man,' she told him, 'is one sentence.'

2. What motivates you to pray? And what can we learn from the prayer life of Jesus in this passage??

SERVE LIKE JESUS

3. Why is HOW we serve so important?

In what ways might you serve sacrificially in this coming week??
