The people who came to Jesus were desperate to meet him and even touch him. They travelled 50 miles or so even when sick and handicapped. Do we have anything like that hunger?

3. What can you do to "get off your perch"?

This coming Sunday we will be covering Luke 7:1 - 8:21. Please encourage your group to take the time to read this section of Luke before pitching up on Sunday.
